ADM - SAFEGUARDING POLICY

Safeguarding is deemed to be the responsibility of every employee within ADM Surveyors Limited. All employees and sub-contractors who, during the course of their engagement have direct or indirect contact with children, families and vulnerable adults, or who have access to information about them, have a responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and vulnerable adults.

ADM Surveyors Limited recognises that it has a duty of care to make appropriate arrangements to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and vulnerable adults and considers it a shared responsibility ensure effective joint working relationships between agencies and professionals that have different roles and expertise in safeguarding the vulnerable.

The statutory inquiry into the death of Victoria Climbié and the first joint Chief Inspectors report on safeguarding children highlighted the lack of priority status given to safeguarding. The government response to these findings included the Green Paper Every Child Matters and the provisions in the Children Act 2004. Section 11 of the Children Act 2004 places a duty on all agencies to make arrangements to safeguard and promote the welfare of children. The Health and Social Care Act 2008 also places statutory duties on organisations and individuals.

What this means for ADM Surveyors Limited.

Safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children, young people and vulnerable adults is not just the province of those working directly with these groups of people.

ADM Surveyors Limited aims to ensure that no act or omission on the part of the organisation, or that of its employees or sub-contractors puts a child, young person or vulnerable adult inadvertently at risk; and that rigorous systems are in place to proactively safeguard and promote the welfare of children, young people and vulnerable adults and support staff in fulfilling their obligations.

This policy applies to anyone employed directly or indirectly by ADM Surveyors Limited and includes suppliers, or sub-contractors.

This policy will be reviewed annually, when circumstances indicate a change is needed or when legislation is introduced that necessitates change.
